SUBJECT: 2010 Title III Annual Measurable Achievement Objectives (AMAOs) Reports Now Available

The purpose of this letter is to notify local education agencies (LEAs) of the availability of 2010 Title III Annual Measurable Achievement Objectives (AMAOs) reports at the Texas Education Agency Secure Environment (TEASE) *NCLB Reports Application*. Please note that all LEAs that have limited English proficient (LEP) students identified in their districts will have a 2010 Title III AMAO report available in TEASE. However, only Title III-funded LEAs will be required to follow the accountability interventions outlined below.

TEASE NCLB Reports Application

Users must have specific access to the *NCLB Reports Application* in order to access AMAO reports. Users who do not have a TEASE login must first establish access to the TEASE application by completing an online request at <https://sequin.tea.state.tx.us/appsng/um/apply.aspx>. Users who have a TEASE login, but need to request access to the *NCLB Reports Application*, may do so by logging on to TEASE at <https://sequin.tea.state.tx.us/apps/logon.asp> and selecting the "Add/Modify Application Access" button, followed by the *NCLB Reports Application* option from the dropdown list. Please allow approximately 10 business days for access to be granted. For detailed information regarding AMAO definitions, standards, and how AMAO results are determined, please consult the *2010 AMAOs Guide* (see resources referenced below).

Title III-Funded LEAs Not Meeting AMAOs

Section 3302(b) of Title III, Part A statute requires that a Title III-funded LEA notify the parents of all LEP students if the LEA fails to meet one or more of the AMAOs. If the 2010 AMAO report indicates that your LEA has not met one or more of the AMAOs, the LEA is required to send a parental notification letter by **October 11, 2010**, in order to comply with the 30 day requirement in statute. Please see the resources referenced below for a sample parental notification letter and instructions for sending the letter. If your LEA has not met the AMAOs for two or more consecutive years, TEA staff will be contacting you soon regarding additional required accountability interventions.
